District Seeks Parents And Community Members To Serve On Technology Planning Project Team

The Beaverton School District is seeking six parents and six community members to serve on the 2011-2014 Technology Planning Project Team. The Project Team will be composed of teachers, parents, administrators, students and community members. The committee will meet at least twice a month beginning in April 2010 and is at present expected to be finished June 2010 with the possibility of extension beyond June should additional time be required. The 2011 - 2014 Technology Plan will support the Beaverton School District Strategic Plan in a number of areas, specifically in relation to the development of customized learning plans for students, providing technology tools to support teacher collaboration, and providing applications and tools to track student growth. In addition to alignment with the District Strategic Plan, the plan will align to both State and Federal Educational Technology Plans.

The 2011 - 2014 Technology Planning Project Team will develop a technology plan to address the following areas:

- Role of technology in classroom instruction and instructional opportunities that extend beyond the physical classroom and school day
- Online education models that best fit the needs of the District
- Role of technology in professional development and staff development needs related to increasing use of information and communications technologies
- Infrastructure needed to support existing and new technologies (i.e. social networking)
- Sustainability
- Technology infrastructure necessary to support the business needs of the organization
- Equitable access to technology tools
