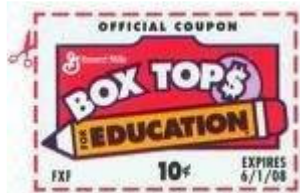

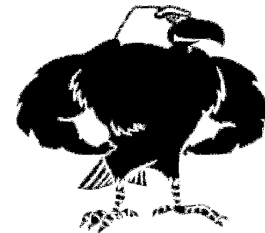

## **VOLUNTEER BACKGROUND CHECKS**

Volunteers have been an essential part of our school for many years, making a significant difference in the lives of students, staff and community. We are grateful for the many contributions parents and community members provide our school.

To protect the safety and welfare of our children, the Beaverton School District conducts background checks on all employees. **Beginning last fall, the District began requiring background checks for volunteers.** The District has been bringing schools into compliance with this new requirement region by region.

Volunteers will need to complete a one page form available online at: [www.beaverton.k12.or.us/volunteer](http://www.beaverton.k12.or.us/volunteer). In addition, there are Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) on this webpage that may answer some of your questions about the process. You may also come in to the school office and use one of the computers to complete this very brief online application. The confidential background checks will be conducted by the District's Public Safety Office at no charge to the volunteer. Once completed, your name and phone number will appear on an approved volunteer list available to appropriate staff and volunteer coordinators. No other information will be included on the list.

We thank you for your patience as we work with this new process to help ensure the safety of our students.
